Raffy Mirzayan, MD

Dr. Raffy Mirzayan graduated from the University of Southern California School of Medicine with Alpha Omega Alpha medical honors. He completed his residency in orthopaedic surgery at the Los Angeles County, University of Southern California Medical Center in Los Angeles, CA, where he was Chief Resident. He then completed a sports medicine fellowship at the prestigious Kerlan-Jobe Orthopaedic Clinic in Los Angeles, where he served as the assistant team physician to the Lakers, Dodgers, Angels, Kings, Galaxy, Sparks. Dr. Mirzayan is currently a Clinical Professor of Orthopaedic Surgery at the University of Southern California Keck School of Medicine. He is the Director of Cartilage Repair and Restoration, Director of Resident Education, the Co-Director of Sports Medicine and at Kaiser Permanente, Baldwin Park, CA.

Dr. Mirzayan has authored numerous peer-reviewed publications and book chapters. He has received several awards including the AOA-Zimmer Award, Vernon P. Thompson Award and DePuy Research Award. He has presented his work at various national and international meetings. He has published three books in the field of orthopaedics and sports medicine.
