J. Michael Waiter, MD

J. Michael Waiter, MD is an orthopaedic surgeon whose practice is limited to arthroscopic and reconstructive shoulder and elbow surgery. Dr. Waiter received his BA degree from the University of Notre Dame in 1989. A graduate of the University of Michigan Medical School in Ann Arbor, Dr. Waiter completed an orthopaedic surgery residency at the University of Michigan Medical Center, followed by a fellowship in shoulder and elbow surgery at Columbia University Medical Center in New York City in 1999. He is a Diplomate of the American Board of Orthopaedic Surgery and holds a Subspecialty Certificate in Orthopaedic Sports Medicine. Dr. Waiter has published many peer-reviewed scientific articles and book chapters and has lectured extensively at regional, national, and international meetings about numerous topics in shoulder and elbow surgery.

In 1999, Dr. Waiter joined the faculty of the Department of Orthopaedic Surgery, Beaumont Health, Royal Oak, MI, where he is the Chief of Shoulder Surgery. Dr. Waiter is a Professor of Orthopaedic Surgery at the Oakland University William Beaumont School of Medicine. He currently trains orthopaedic surgery residents and fellows and conducts original scientific research. He is the Program Director for the ACGME-accredited Fellowship in Adult Reconstruction-Shoulder and Elbow Surgery. In 2012, the orthopaedic surgery residents honored Dr. Waiter with the Teacher of the Year Award. He holds active memberships in the American Shoulder and Elbow Surgeons, American Orthopaedic Association, and the American Academy of Orthopaedic Surgeons. Dr. Waiter is a founding Editor-in-Chief for Seminars in Arthroplasty: Journal of Shoulder and Elbow Surgery. In addition, Dr. Waiter has served as an Oral Examiner for the American Board of Orthopaedic Surgery and is a reviewer and editor for multiple peer-reviewed orthopaedic publications. His primary clinical and investigative interests include the outcomes and design of anatomic and reverse total shoulder arthroplasties. He has a busy private practice in Beverly Hills, MI and has been selected by his peers as an Hour Detroit Magazine Top Doc.
